SUBJECT: Environmental Statement

1. The 122nd Fighter Wing is committed to conducting its mission in an environmentally responsible manner that will protect human health, natural resources and the environment. In doing so, we will comply with all environmental laws and regulations applicable to the conduct of our mission. Including laws and regulations established by the Federal, State and local authorities, as well as Executive Orders and US Air Force Instructions. The 122nd Fighter Wing will strive for continual improvement in our environmental performance and will set an example in the field of environmental management. This commitment goes beyond compliance with the law and encompasses the integration of sound environmental practices into our daily decisions and activities. In support of our environmental policy, we will:
 - a. Maintain an effective Environmental Management System (EMS), promote the use of safe technologies and operating practices, and remain ready to respond to emergencies in order to improve our environmental performance and minimize adverse impacts to the installation workers and the environment.
 - b. Working in partnership with all stakeholders, investigate and evaluate new and innovative technologies and practices as appropriate, establish and implement an effective pollution prevention program, minimize the generation of wastes, recycle materials otherwise destined to become waste when possible and dispose of any remaining wastes in an environmentally responsible manner.
 - c. Ensure the responsible use of energy throughout the installation, including the adoption of innovative practices and procedures that will conserve energy and improve energy efficiency.
2. Compliance with this Environmental Policy is the responsibility of everyone supporting the 122nd Fighter Wing including: military, state and civilian employees, tenants, contractors and vendors in accordance with his or her role and responsibilities in the organization.
